

Understanding the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR)

What is a Consumer Confidence Report?

A Consumer Confidence Report, also known as a CCR, is a brief annual water quality report about your water and your water system. The primary purpose of the CCR is to summarize water quality data that your water system collects. It will also include information on compliance, source water, and some required educational information. Most CCRs only need to be a few pages long.

A CCR tells you where your water comes from and what the water system does to deliver safe drinking water to your homes. It also informs you about any contaminants present in your drinking water and how these contaminants could affect your health.

How do I access my CCR?

To access your CCR, go to the "Forms & Reports" section and click on "Water Quality Reports". This will take you to the water quality reports page where you can find the report for your water system.
